Please submit abstracts on topics related to global Jesuit studies on the subjects of: history, literature and theater, art/architectural history, music history, ethnography, religious studies, or related topics, of no more than 150 words, along with a short list of keywords, and a BRIEF CV (no more than 300 words, including affiliation, PhD completion date, rank, discipline, and one or two important publications or other evidence of scholarship) to Kathleen Comerford, kcomerfo@georgiasouthern.edu, **no later than August 1, 2020.** We will consider panels, individual papers, and roundtables for sponsorship by the *Journal of Jesuit Studies*.
