The Annemarie Schimmel-Foundation for Islamic Studies (Bonn) calls for recommendations for the 2022 grant of its biennial Research Award. Eligible for the award are outstanding research contributions (usually in the form of a dissertation) in the field of Islamic Studies. The awardee will be received for ceremony at the <u>Deutscher Orientalistentag 2022</u> in Berlin and will be issued with a 5000 Euro prize. Please be aware that the award may be shared. The board of the Annemarie Schimmel Foundation for Islamic Studies therefore opens its call for submissions and recommendations, which are to be submitted until May 31st 2022.

The board, in cooperation with the DMG section Islamic Studies, will evaluate all the eligible proposals after the closure of the call. Recommendations may be submitted by all university professors and by PhD-holding members of the DMG, recommendations of non-German studies are explicitly welcomed. A submission should consist of an electronic version of the research work and a short explanatory statement (1-2 A4 pages).

Applications by candidates themselves may also be accepted. If you are planning to submit your own research contribution, please do so in electronic form, including an abstract and a CV.

Please note that contributions will only be taken into account if they have been published in the five years before the deadline; publications before May 31st 2017 will not be eligible for the award. Unpublished dissertations may be considered if they are accompanied by the report of the supervisor and an additional expert opinion.
